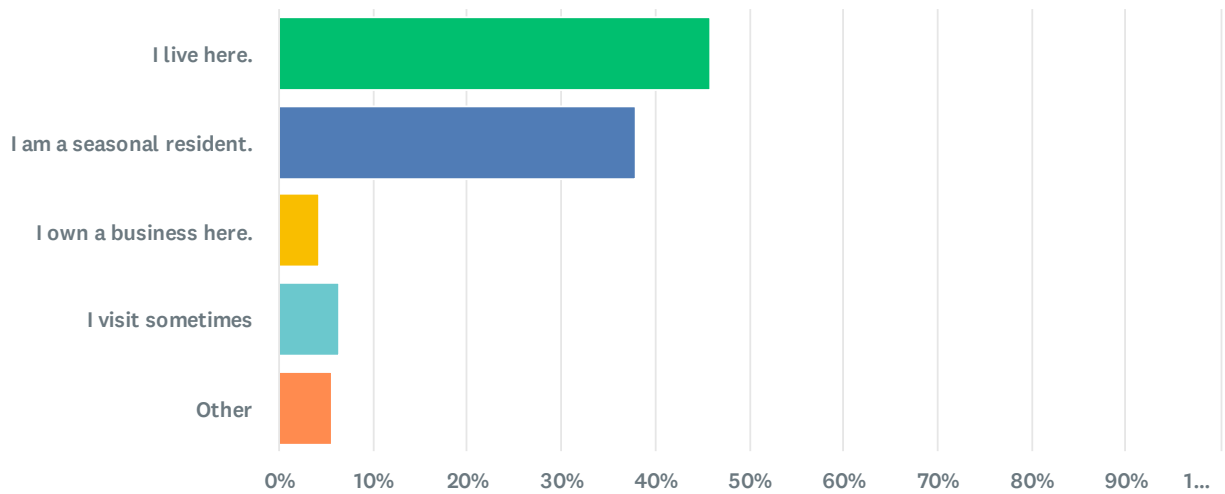

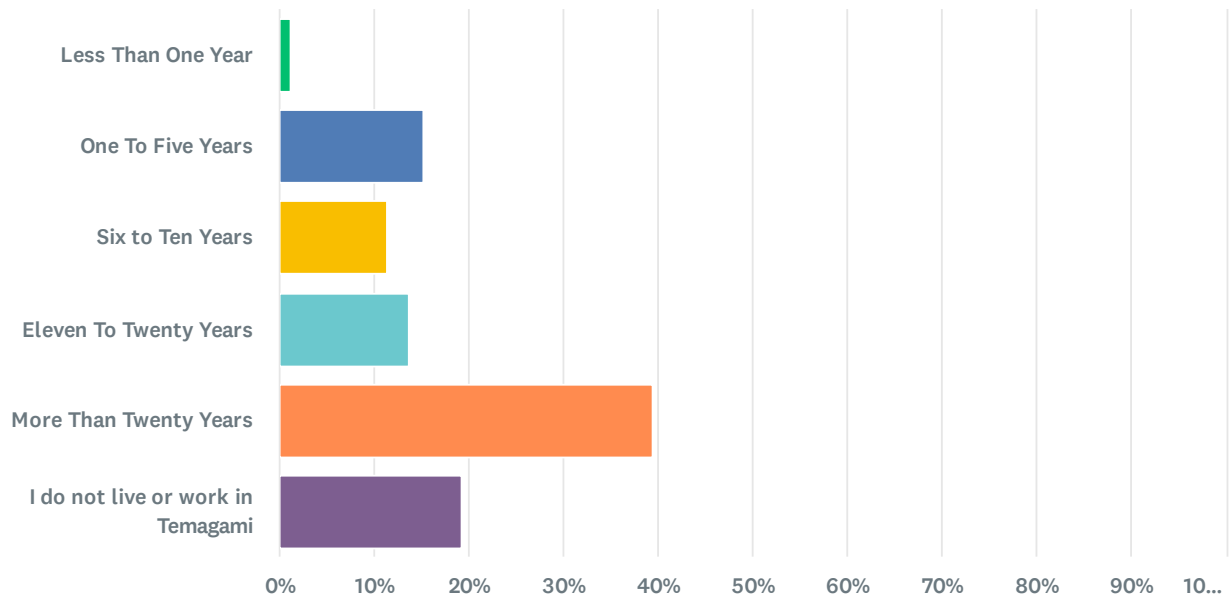

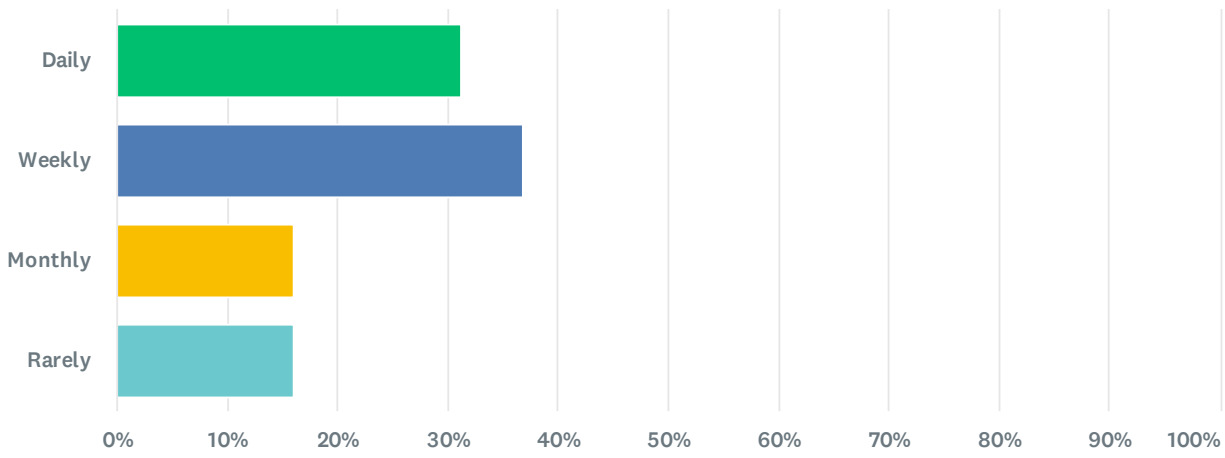

Q3 How often do you go to downtown Temagami?

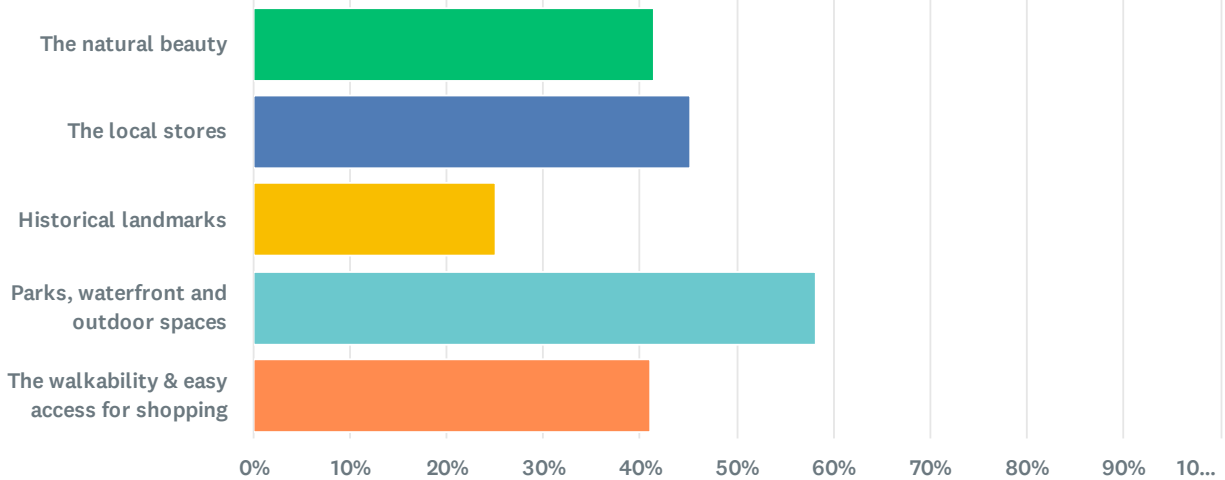

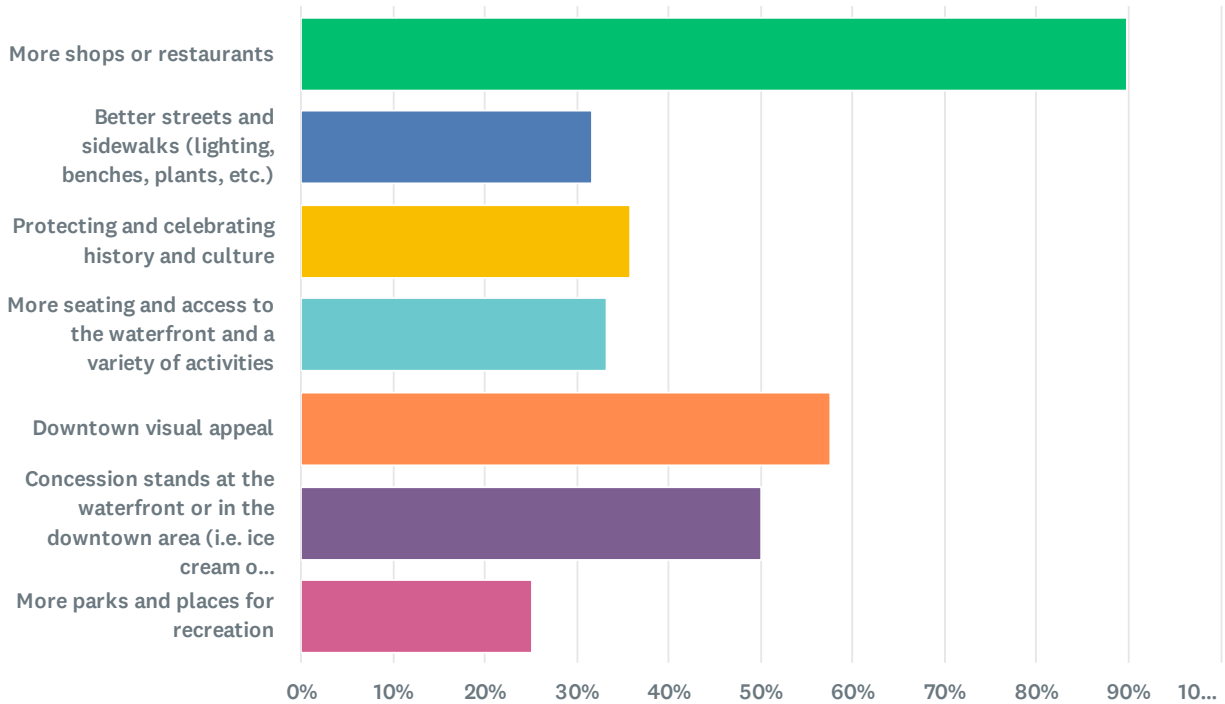

We had a great mini putt once by the Temagami skateboard park area. Now there are no seniors available to run it, perhaps summer students could work there? People like to pay for fun! We had an exciting vision/plan and illustration which involved the following ideas, all of which are not currently available in town yet: A small splash park area, small fun playground for kids, community garden area, public washrooms which are desperately needed in town and at the Temagami Landing area. (If you are of a more vintage age you know what I mean.) There is space in the currently free parking area in front of the Temagami Medical Clinic, which was the proposed land area for this park. As I have said many times in meetings, every small town across Canada has a central park area which people/ tourists can use for a picnic, road rest stop, or family reunion/birthday party, small outdoor shows or concerts, etc. Ike Laba was on our committees after he was mayor and when he was mayor. envisioned. He suggested a dumping station for RVs as well, while people stopped for that they might check out our town businesses. There were plans to provide a dog rest area for the 70 percent (just a guess) of people travelling with their pets. This was to be at the back of that land area. Currently the area used by dog owners consists of any parking areas, train station, abandoned grassy area and the waterfront small gazebo area. Disgusting!! Your current chairperson shot it down as well, so I am not holding my breath for it ever happening here. She said to me: 'Our town park is the waterfront area', which in my view, is a pretty limited patch of grass that is too small to host many events and very much just for show. Hey you said this is the fun part! As someone who has worked in tourism and in retail in Temagami over many years, I cannot tell you how many times families came in to ask: 1) Where is there a washroom? (food store does not allow and station option has very limited hours) 2) What else is there to do or see here, we have already been up to the tower? 3) Where is there a good place to eat? 4) Where is there a beach or playground and boat launch or canoe/kayak rentals? No tourists know about the Tem. North beach. The only beach close to town is Finlayson Prov. Park and you must buy a day pass to access it. 5) Where can we buy: beach towels/toys, swimsuits and trunks for kids and adults, flip flops, sweaters, pillows and extra blankets for camping, and so on. Camping was colder than they thought. (And the answer for them is to drive up to Temiskaming Shores Giant Tiger or Walmart) The current playground in Temagami North is really almost a liability and should be removed and replaced. The beautiful track area and the tennis/basketball court are barely used for all the \$ that went into them. In Powassan, and Sturgeon Falls, beside parking lots for example, there is an area of permanent wooden stalls for vendors at farmer and craft markets. Why not have this for our market? The season could be longer and vendors wouldn't have to fold up their tents and displays every weekend? Well, these are my comments. I am available if you would care to discuss with me or highjack them for your group? Unfortunately, due to your lack of trust in my personal ethics regarding discretion, you would not allow me to even sit in on one of your meetings. Pretty ironic considering I was on the committee; saw all your credentials and participated in giving you the opportunity to be on this Corp. (By the way I am a former 20 year Federal government employee, so I do know a lot about keeping quiet!) If you care to know what happened to the grant money of around \$50,000 council heartily supported the purchase of the ugly recycled permanent and generic park benches and planters; some of which line the sidewalks of Hwy 11. You can sit and rest on your short walking tour of downtown and enjoy the dust from the 100,000 or so CMV's that speed through town year round! May I also suggest purchases of this nature should include local businesses i.e. Owners of Peacock Chair Co. Colleen Pender and Pete Neilsbach provided the wonderful "Christmas Walk" for no cost to the municipality, for at least 10 years. This event could not continue as it got too popular and large and there were not enough volunteers to keep it going or municipal interest and support. This wonderful family know how to support a town. Sadly, in that instance I guess we saved a few bucks by going to a huge company down in Burlington, ON. to supply the benches.
